NARRATIVE

On Friday 05/17/2024 at about 0137 hours while Officer Wood was assigned to the J431A unit did respond to the Faulkner Hospital at 1153 Centre St. for a **Motor Vehicle Accident W/Injuries**.

On arrival Officer Wood observed Boston Fire Engine 28 was on scene treating an injured female [REDACTED]. Officer Wood spoke to Boston Firefighters on scene, and they inform him that the suspect somehow drove her vehicle off the top floor of the garage, Officer Wood then observed a heavily damaged 2018 white Jeep Grand Cherokee with Ma reg [REDACTED] next to a smaller garage with all its doors open and what appeared to be all of its air bags being deployed. Vehicle was a private tow and towed by the Falkner Hospital Security because it was on private property per the J908 Sgt. Wosny.

Responding Boston EMS units were the 1A18 Lashley 880786, O'Brien 881062, the 1P05 Howard 880239, Rivas 880264, 1D02 Steeves 880038.

Officer Wood then noticed the bronze-colored reeling on the ground and then looking up observed the top floor of the Falkner Hospital main Garage had that same section of reeling missing. Officer Wood then observed the injured being moved into Boston EMS Paramedic Ambulance 1P05 for transport to the Brigham and womans Hospital for emergency treatment.

Officer Wood entered Paramedic Ambulance 1P05 and spoke [REDACTED] and asked what happened and if she was the registered owner of the white Grand Cherokee and she stated she was the owner and then stated she was cold that when Boston Paramedic Howard stated that the injured suspect stated "[REDACTED]".
[REDACTED] Officer Wood told them he would follow then to the Hospital.

Officer Wood then asked about the nature of her [REDACTED] injuries and Paramedic Howard stated broken arm and back and leg injuries and that they will be transporting her to the trauma unit at the Brigham and Womans Hospital.

Officer Wood was informed to follow the injured [REDACTED] to the hospital and check on her injuries. While at the hospital Officer Wood spoke to Dr. Darling and was informed that [REDACTED] had some broken bones and was in stable but severe condition and they would know more after a cat-scan.

NARRATIVE

Officer Murray (JD22, E13 Auto Investigator) conducted an investigation into this accident.

Officer Murray responded to the Brigham and Women's Hospital and spoke with the victim [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated that she worked her normal shift from until about 5:30 pm. She stated that she left the premises and went to get dinner (pizza) and returned back to the hospital at about 7:00 pm. She also stated that she was on-call beginning at 11pm, so instead of driving home she stayed and slept in her vehicle. [REDACTED] stated that she woke up sometime after 1:00 am because the light from the overhead lights were in her eyes, and she decided to move away from the lights. [REDACTED] stated that as she was moving her vehicle, she accidentally hit the gas instead of the brake and went through the metal guard-rail and metal railing. She also stated that her vehicle began to "teeter" and she attempted to put the car in reverse but was unsuccessful and landed on the ground below. She sustained multiple injuries and will be under the care of the Emergency Department at Brigham and Women's Hospital for approximately 2 to 3 more days.

Officer Murray then responded to the Faulkner Hospital and spoke with Chief Baker of the Faulkner Hospital Security. He advised Officer Murray that a report was in the process of being completed and that when done, will be sent over to Officer Murray. Chief Baker stated that the vehicle was totaled, and multiple items were found outside near the shed area. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Measurements were taken of the accident scene by Chief Baker. The vehicle was towed by Akiki Towing via a private tow. The area of the parking garage and impact spot were photographed by Officer Murray.

Officer Murray then responded to Akiki Towing and took photographs of the vehicle. Officer Murray observed the vehicle's roof to be crushed in, a gash that tore the metal on the driver's side door as well as damage to the entirety of the vehicle. The front passenger side tire was flat, and all airbags had deployed. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Officer asked Akiki to hold the vehicle pending a search warrant for the black box data information.

Officer Murray then recontacted [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] Officer Murray advised [REDACTED] that he would be completing a search warrant for that information as well. At 12:43 pm, Officer Murray received a message from [REDACTED] "Nelson Toxicology lab confirmed negative" and was then provided with a copy of the victim's ethanol report (dated 5/17/2024 at 2:24 am, which showed a "Negative" result.

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Based on the damage to the guard rail and flat metal panel at the edge of the roof, and the damage to the shed, and the distance that the vehicle traveled prior to impact with the shed, Officer Murray advised [REDACTED] that the vehicle would be held pending a search warrant for the black box data.

The vehicle was ACTIVE to the victim, [REDACTED] and her license is ACTIVE.

NARRATIVE

The search warrant authorized the search of a 2018 Jeep Grand Cherokee bearing Massachusetts Registration [REDACTED]. The search warrant was issued by the Honorable Judge Coffey of the West Roxbury District Court authorizing the collection of data and items of potential evidence.

The vehicle was located inside the garage of Akiki Towing, located at 6 A Street, Hyde Park, Massachusetts. The search and inspection of the above listed vehicle began at approximately 2:44 pm.

The following persons were in attendance and conducting the search: Sgt. Det. Barrett (V966), Officer Murray (JD22, E13 Auto Investigator), Officer Powell (JT55, Traffic Enforcement).

The search was concluded at approximately 3:20 pm. The vehicle was released by the Boston Police Department. An inventory of items were recorded on the search warrant return and returned to West Roxbury Court on May 28th, 2024.
