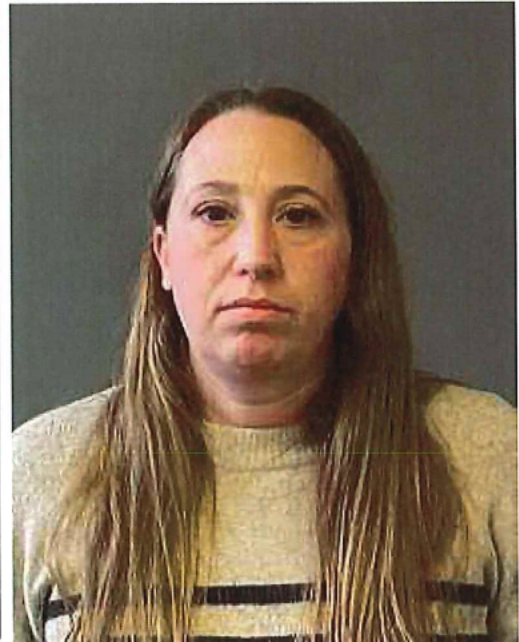

OVERVIEW OF INCIDENT

On September 7, 2023 at approximately 1226 hours, personnel from the Troop K – Colchester barracks responded to the town of Columbia for a report of a sexual assault involving a juvenile male. The criminal investigation developed probable cause to show the arrestee, Alyson Cranick (DOB: 05/28/1981), had sexual intercourse with the victim on multiple occasions in the town of Columbia during July and August of 2022.

CRIMINAL INFORMATION SUMMARY

OVERVIEW OF INCIDENT

On November 14, 2023 at approximately 0500 hours, Alyson Cranick turned herself in at the Troop K barracks, where she was taken into custody on the strength of an active arrest warrant issued by GA #19 Rockville JD. Cranick was processed and charged with violating C.G.S. 53a-70(a)(2) Sexual Assault 1st degree (2 counts) and C.G.S. 53-21(a)(2) Injury, or risk of injury to, or impairing morals of, children (3 counts). Cranick was held on a court set \$500,000 cash/surety bond and is scheduled to appear at GA #19 on 11/14/2023 at approximately 0900 hours.



The undersigned affiant, being duly sworn, deposes and says:

1. That I, the Affiant, Detective Matthew A. Rei #793, being duly sworn, does depose and state that I am a regular sworn member of the Connecticut Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection, Division of State Police, and has been a member of said department since June 2013. This Affiant presently holds the rank of Detective and is assigned to Eastern District Major Crime - Troop K, located in Colchester, CT. At all times mentioned herein, the Affiant was acting as an official member of said department. That, during the course of this Affiant's career, he has conducted numerous investigations that have ultimately resulted in the arrest and conviction of the involved offender(s). The Affiant has received formal training regarding the laws of arrest and laws pertaining to Search and Seizure from The Connecticut State Police Academy and has received specialized training in various areas of investigations and how to process the scenes of such crimes. The following facts and circumstances are stated from personal knowledge, observation, and investigation, as well as, the information received from fellow Troopers/Police Officers acting in their official capacity, and from official police reports.

2. That, in accordance with Connecticut General Statute 54-86e, the name and address of the victim is withheld in this affidavit. The victim, an eleven-year-old male at the time of the incidents, with a date of birth of [REDACTED] will be referred to as "Victim #1."

3. That, on September 7, 2023 at approximately 1226 hours, personnel from the Troop K - Colchester barracks responded to a report of a sexual assault involving a juvenile male that occurred in 2022. Initial investigative efforts revealed Victim #1 disclosed to a relative, Witness #1, he had been in a sexual relationship with the accused, Alyson Cranick (DOB: 05/28/1981), during July and August of 2022.

4. That, on September 12, 2023 at approximately 1430 hours, this Affiant attended the forensic interview of Victim #1 at a child friendly location in the Town of Killingly. During the interview, Victim #1

disclosed to being "sexually assaulted" by Cranick. He explained that "sexually assaulted" meant "she forced me to insert my penis into her vagina." Victim #1 explained that he was [REDACTED]. Victim #1 revealed that initially he and Cranick communicated via iMessage and Snapchat. After Cranick learned that Witness #1 looked through Victim #1's iMessage and Snapchat applications, she suggested they communicate on Discord because Witness #1 did not look through that. During the summer of 2022, Victim #1 started sneaking out of his house around 1:00am or 2:00am to meet with Cranick. Victim #1 explained that on nights he snuck out to meet Cranick, she parked her car on his street or at [REDACTED] in the town of Columbia, CT. Cranick either waited for Victim #1 by hiding behind a bush on a neighbor's property or walking up to his house. After meeting up, Victim #1 and Cranick usually went to [REDACTED] or [REDACTED] in Columbia, CT. It should be known that Victim #1's street is [REDACTED]. Victim #1 disclosed that at [REDACTED] he and Cranick kissed and at [REDACTED] they had sexual intercourse in her vehicle. During his forensic interview, he described one instance at [REDACTED] in detail. Victim #1 recalled that Cranick drove to [REDACTED] around 2:00a/3:00a. There she kissed Victim #1, took her shirt and bra off, and took off Victim #1's shorts and underwear. Cranick went into the backseat of the vehicle and motioned for Victim #1 to come as well. Cranick took her shorts and underwear off and "took her hand on my penis and put it in her." Victim #1 described Cranick as laying down on the backseat and that he was on top of her. Victim #1 recalled another instance when he and Cranick had sexual intercourse at [REDACTED] but that he was sitting down in the backseat of her vehicle and she was on top of him. Victim #1 said he was always tired because he was not getting enough sleep since he was sneaking out during the night. Cranick then purchased him caffeinated drinks (energy drinks and soda) to help him stay awake. Victim #1 explained that Cranick always volunteered to chaperone [REDACTED]. During these instances, Cranick picked Victim #1 up an hour or two early, when she and Victim #1 spent time alone. On two or three occasions, Cranick took Victim #1 to [REDACTED] in Colchester, CT, where they did the "same thing that happened at [REDACTED]." He described that Cranick took his pants off, took her top off, they got into the backseat of her vehicle, and had intercourse. They also kissed and he touched her breasts under her bra at that location. Victim #1 described other incidents that occurred during the summer of 2022 related to his relationship with Cranick. He explained that in August 2022, he was at [REDACTED] with Cranick, when she had her hand on his inner thigh and asked him to do the same to her. [REDACTED] observed this and reported it to the police. Victim #1 described another incident when his neighbor posted a picture of Cranick's vehicle on Facebook they felt was suspicious for being parked on their street during the overnight hours. In addition to purchasing Victim #1 caffeinated drinks, Cranick also offered to buy Victim #1 an airsoft gun and Apple AirPods. Victim #1 did not think it was a good idea for Cranick to purchase him an airsoft gun because if his parents found it, he would not be able to explain how he purchased it. Cranick gave Victim #1 \$300.00 to purchase the gun instead. Victim #1 revealed that he only disclosed his sexual relationship with Cranick to Witness #1 and his therapist, [REDACTED].

5. That, after the forensic interview, this Affiant met with relatives of Victim #1. During that meeting, Witness #1 sent this Affiant three hundred ninety-two (392) screenshots of Discord messages related to conversations between Cranick and Victim #1 from July 16, 2022 to October 14, 2022. This Affiant later reviewed the messages, which revealed they were between Discord username "Razzberry#2560" or "Razzberry" and [REDACTED] (Victim #1's account). Based upon the context of the messages, as well as Victim #1 identifying her as the user, Cranick is believed to be the person communicating as Discord user "Razzberry." The messages revealed many consistencies with Victim #1's forensic interview. They showed that from the beginning of their conversation until September 2022, Cranick encouraged Victim #1 to sneak out almost nightly after his family members had gone to sleep. Cranick also assisted Victim #1 with sneaking out by telling him if any lights were on in his house and reminding him to lock the door or window he had used to get in or out. The messages revealed Victim #1 snuck out of his house on at least fourteen (14) occasions during the overnight hours to meet with Cranick, in addition to meeting up with her during the day. The messages also confirmed that on multiple occasions Cranick purchased Victim #1 caffeinated drinks to help him stay awake at night. Cranick's messages to Victim #1 were often flirtatious and sexual in nature. During their conversations, Cranick told Victim #1 he should come home with her, suggested he shower with her, that she wanted Victim #1 in bed laying on top of her, and that she wished she was home alone so they could be there together. Cranick also sent Victim #1 a picture of a letter beaded bracelet she made for him with the acronym "BFFFLWB." Victim #1 later explained that Cranick told him "BFFFLWB" meant "Best Friends for Life with Benefits." In the Discord messages, Cranick told Victim #1 not to tell anybody it was about her and if somebody asked, tell them it meant "Best Friends Forever for Life We're Better." The messages showed numerous instances when Cranick used her influence over Victim #1 to try and emotionally manipulate him into spending more time with her. On multiple occasions, Victim #1 told Cranick he could not sneak out that evening. Cranick then tried to persuade Victim #1 to do so by telling him she had something good for him or that she needed him. She then repeatedly insisted on them getting together or told Victim #1 if he snuck out, they would not be out too long. The Discord messages also showed multiple instances when Cranick suggested to Victim #1 how he should ask his relatives for things that would justify them spending more time together. This included telling Victim #1 how he should ask Witness #1 if he could teach Cranick how to fish or to get permission to use his Snapchat account again because she missed seeing pictures of him. On July 21, 2022, Cranick and Victim #1 discussed the incident related to a picture of her vehicle being posted on a Town of Columbia Facebook page. Later in the messages, Cranick mentioned talking to Witness #2, another relative of Victim #1, about the Facebook post and telling him, "That I was at [REDACTED] sitting but didn't want to park there because I wasn't sure if [REDACTED]" Witness #2 confirmed to this Affiant this conversation occurred and was the excuse Cranick provided as to why she parked on Victim #1's street. During his forensic interview, Victim #1 revealed Cranick was not being honest with

Witness #2 and the truth was that she had taken Victim #1 to [REDACTED], where they sat [REDACTED] and kissed. On [REDACTED] it was reported to the State Police by the [REDACTED] that [REDACTED] had observed Cranick acting flirtatious with Victim #1 while at [REDACTED]. The Discord messages showed that on July 26, 2022, Cranick and Victim #1 made plans to meet at [REDACTED]. Later in the day, Cranick messaged Victim #1 on Discord and said, "Hey, if anyone asks, I was down at [REDACTED] talking with some other adult and you asked for my help. K?" The messages showed that by September 3, 2022, Victim #1 refused to sneak out to see Cranick due to being woken up early every day for school, which was consistent with what he mentioned during his forensic interview. On September 9, 2022, Cranick messaged Victim #1 and told him [REDACTED] [REDACTED] she bought him from an airsoft website he sent her had arrived. Victim #1 refused to meet up with Cranick and explained around this time he injured his foot and hand. In Victim #1's forensic interview, he explained he got hurt playing [REDACTED] and was using [REDACTED] as an excuse as to why he could not meet with her. On October 10, 2022, Victim #1 told Cranick, "stop messaging me to come talk." The last message in the conversation was on October 14, 2022, when Cranick messaged Victim #1, but he never responded.

6. That, on September 12, 2023, Detectives from Eastern District Major Crime met with Cranick at her residence and spoke to her about the accusations made by Victim #1. During the interview, Cranick denied initiating any sexual contact with Victim #1. She downplayed any inappropriate reasoning for communicating with Victim #1 and explained she was "trying to comfort him because he is scared" related to family issues. When asked if the messages were flirtatious or sexual in nature, Cranick said she did not mean for them to come across that way and that she is just a "really nice person." Cranick admitted to previously having a Discord account but claimed she could not remember the username. When directly asked if she used "Razzberry" as her username, she said she did not remember and "it could have been."

7. That, on September 27, 2023, this Affiant received [REDACTED] medical records related to Victim #1's [REDACTED]

8. That, on October 12, 2023 at approximately 1755 hours, Detectives from Eastern District Major Crime met with Victim #1 and his parents for a follow up interview. Throughout the interview, Victim #1's responses were consistent with information disclosed during his forensic interview and revealed in his Discord messages with Cranick. Victim #1 disclosed that he had sexual intercourse with Cranick at [REDACTED]

He described that he went to ██████████ with Cranick multiple times during the afternoon (between 1:00p and 5:00p), prior to Cranick chaperoning ██████████

9. That, after speaking with Victim #1 on October 12, 2023, Witness #1 provided this Affiant with two (2) monthly statements from Victim #1's cellular phone plan, to include call logs. The monthly statement of June 10, 2022 to July 9, 2022 "Talk Activity" showed three (3) calls between Victim #1's cell phone and Cranick's cell phone, all after 10:54pm. The monthly statement of July 10, 2022 to August 9, 2022 "Talk Activity" showed sixteen (16) calls between Victim #1's cell phone and Cranick's cell phone, to include six calls between 10:30pm and 4:00am.

10. That, based upon the aforementioned facts and circumstances, this Affiant finds probable cause to believe and does believe that Alyson Cranick (DOB: 05/28/1981), a white female last known to be residing in Allentown, Pennsylvania, has committed crimes in violation of the Connecticut General Statutes. This Affiant respectfully requests that an arrest warrant be issued.
